Fencing

The fence has required little maintenance in the last three months. I have had to clear some timber. The current condition is excellent.

Vehicle Access

The vehicle access track has not required any maintenance in the last three months. The current condition is excellent. Have plans for a Grader to run tracks in early January.

Weed Management

Spot spraying of Dutchmans Pipe and Lantana. Previously treated plants are responding well to treatment.

Planting

No Plantings have occurred in this quarter.

Fire Management

No fire control has been required this quarter.

Monitoring

All plants are in good health. *Pomaderris clivicola* are producing new growth and are of a deep green colour. The *Bertya pedicellata* are producing new fresh shoots and are also of a deep green colour. There have been no losses to be recorded.

20/10/15	Monitoring	Inspected OMS all is looking well. Plants are doing great since recent rain. Spot sprayed Dutchmans Pipe and some Lantana Roads and Fences are in excellent condition.
15/11/15	Monitoring	Inspected OMS Inspected Roads and Fences all in excellent condition.
21/12/15	Monitoring	Inspected OMS Inspected Roads and fences. Measured 45mm Rain There was some damage to fences and a lot of timber down around plant plots but no damage to any plants. Have organized to have a grader in early January to run fence line and roads also too shift timber and clear access to plots.
