## •Fencing

The fence has required little maintenance in the last three months. The current condition is excellent.

## •Vehicle Access

The vehicle access track has had a grader over it. The current condition is excellent.

## •Weed Management

The declared weeds found on site and treated are Lantana. Spot spraying has commenced and previously treated plants are responding well to treatment.

## •Planting

No Plantings have occurred in this quarter. We have organized to pick up 100+ plants from USC in early April 2016.

## •Fire Management

We put a grader around the fence line and into plants position.

## •Monitoring

All plants are in good health. *Pomaderris clivicola* are producing new growth and are of a deep green colour. The *Bertya pedicellata* are producing new fresh shoots and are also of a deep green colour. There have been no losses to be recorded.
