7.3 B-Double Report – West Woodmillar Road

Cr KS Wendt OAM BEM moved and Cr WJ Bowen seconded: That the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator be advised that:

1. The route description provided in the application and the route shown on the NHVR Journey Planner do not reflect existing Council road network infrastructure. Having regard for the start and end point in these documents, Council has considered the public infrastructure route as Burnett Highway, Meson St, Spencer St, Arthur St, Naylor St and West Woodmillar Rd.

2. Council does not endorse approval of the permit application for 25 metre B-Double vehicles to travel from Burnett Highway along Meson St, Spencer St, Arthur St, Naylor St and West Woodmillar Road, within the North Burnett Regional Council area due to:

- a. Intersection inadequacy at Arthur St / Naylor St
- b. Curves on West Woodmillar Road that do not have curve widening to cater for proposed vehicles, and
- c. Steep road grades

3. Council's decision does not include consideration of the intersection of Burnett Highway with Meson Street, as the assessment of this intersection would be undertaken by the Qld Department of Transport and Main Roads. **CARRIED 7/0**

7.4 B-Double Report – Faulks Road

Cr WJ Bowen moved and Cr PW Francis seconded: That the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator be advised that:

1. The route description provided in the application and the route shown on the NHVR Journey Planner do not reflect existing Council road network infrastructure. Having regard for the start and end point in these documents, Council has considered the public infrastructure route as Burnett Highway, Ideraway Rd, Dalgangal Rd and Faulks Rd.

2. Council does not endorse approval of the permit application for 25 metre B-Double vehicles to travel from Burnett Highway along Ideraway Road, Dalgangal Road and Faulks Road, within the North Burnett Regional Council area due to the current standard of the Faulks Road, especially

- a. Unsealed road segments with grades greater than 5%
- b. Inadequacy of pavement width to cater for intersection with Dalgangal Rd
- c. Curve with inadequate pavement width
- d. Inadequate pavement standards.

3. Council's decision does not include consideration of the intersection of Burnett Highway with Ideraway Road, as the assessment of this intersection would be undertaken by the Qld Department of Transport and Main Roads. **CARRIED 7/0**
