



Waste Management Fees

As of the 1st of July 2017, the following fees will apply at all Council's Waste Management Facilities. Contact the Environmental Health Section on 1300 696 272 or visit www.northburnett.qld.gov.au, if you require more information.

RECYCLABLES

Clean loads* of the following items are accepted as recyclables by North Burnett Regional Council:

Batteries	No charge
Waste Mechanical Oil (domestic quantities – less than 150 litres)	No charge
Clean Fill	No charge
DrumMuster – approved containers only, triple rinsed	No charge
Cardboard and Paper Waste	No charge
Ferrous and Non-Ferrous Metals	No charge
Types 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 Plastics (Refer to Plastic Recycling Fact Sheet on Council website)	No charge

*Only items listed above are classed as recyclable. *Clean load means recyclable items have been separated and do not contain residue. It does not include any other waste which is chargeable.*

GENERAL WASTE (Domestic) – Excluding Tyres/ Asbestos and INCLUDING Green Waste

Domestic Waste Only – North Burnett residents/ratepayers (proof of current residency/ratepayer MUST be supplied at each visit to landfill)

Domestic Waste up to 1 m ³	No Charge
Domestic Waste above 1 m ³	\$10.00 per m ³ above 1 m ³
Green Waste (Uncontaminated) including tree waste and grass clippings – up to 1 m ³	No Charge
Green Waste (Uncontaminated) including tree waste and grass clippings – above to 1 m ³	\$10.00 per m ³ above 1 m ³
Green Waste (Contaminated) – per m ³ or part thereof	\$21.00 per m ³

GENERAL WASTE (Commercial) – Excluding Tyres/ Asbestos and INCLUDING Green Waste

Commercial Waste Only – North Burnett businesses/residents/ratepayers (proof of current residency/ratepayer MUST be supplied at each visit to landfill)

Commercial General Waste	\$10.00 per m ³
Commercial Green Waste (Uncontaminated) including tree waste and grass clippings	\$10.00 per m ³
Green Waste (Contaminated) – per m ³ or part thereof	\$21.00 per m ³

Non North Burnett Residents/ratepayers – Minimum charge \$6.00

Up to 240 Litres (wheelie bin or sedan boot)	\$ 6.00 each or part thereof
Sedan/ Station Wagon	\$7.00 each or part thereof
Utility/ Van/ 6 x 4 trailer	\$ 11.00 each or part thereof
Large Trailers/ Trucks/ Truck-Dog/ Skips (other) - \$11.00 for each additional m ³ or part thereof	\$ 11.00 per m ³
Green Waste (Uncontaminated) including tree waste and grass clippings	\$11.00 per m ³
Green Waste (Contaminated)	\$ 21.00 per m ³

Uncontaminated material suitable for landfill cover and placed where requested	No charge

Mulch/ Green waste chip is available for collection free of charge - Must be self loaded	No Charge

REGULATED WASTE

Asbestos (min charge \$35.00) – by appointment and subject to approval by Manager of Environmental Services prior to disposal	\$ 109.00/ per m ³
Contaminated Soil – subject to written approval by Environmental Services (Acceptance subject to waste acceptance criteria as per individual Landfill Licence)	\$ 54.00 per m ³

Decant Refrigeration Gas on Fridges/Freezers and Air-Conditioning Units (includes cars) per unit	No Charge
Disposal of LPG Gas Bottles (empty only)	No Charge
Call out fee (for disposal outside normal hours) – Subject to availability	\$ 215.00
Invoice fee – administration fee for accounts per month	\$ 11.50

Please note that customers are encouraged to provide the correct amount of money for disposal charges, as Waste Management Facilities do not keep large amounts of cash on site. Some facilities are unable to receive all 'Recyclable' or 'Regulated' wastes, please confirm with the facility or the Environmental Health Section as to what can be accepted.
