For those of us who live in the North Burnett fire is a part of our lives. Each year some farmers choose to use fire as an agricultural tool and burn off their properties. These burns need a permit from the local fire warden and are usually very well controlled. I for one, look forward to the beautiful red sunsets which these burns produce.

Last week's weather conditions resulted in all permits to burn being suspended. QFES does an amazing job monitoring conditions and informing council, along with other agencies as to upcoming fire conditions.

The fuel load in our dry grass is enormous and our soil is extremely dry so the potential for fire to get away at this time is high. Therefore, we all need to be aware of how we live with this fire threat.

Firstly, for everyone with permits to burn, before doing so please contact your local fire warden for the latest advice. Although permits are issued with a date range for use, conditions can change substantially over that time.

Secondly, if you see a fire that is not controlled (or if QFES or Rural Fire is not in attendance) please call triple zero '000'.

Thirdly, there unfortunately has been some recent fires which have been suspected to have been deliberately lit. Personally, I have trouble comprehending the stupidity of this. As a community we ask you to be vigilant and if you suspect any arson please contact Crimestoppers with whatever information you have. "If you see something, know something, then say something..." We need to help each other out with this one.

Lastly, I'd like to thank QFES staff and our rural volunteers who spend many hours protecting life and property, many times at their own risk. You all do an outstanding job and we are lucky to have you.

SNAP SEND SOLVE

Snap Send Solve is a free app that allows residents to take a photo of an issue such as broken playground equipment or illegal dumping and email the responsible council to report the problem.

Snap Send Solve uses your phone and GPS to determine the responsible Council and sends the information instantly.



ROADSIDE GRAZING AND STOCK ROUTES

Emerging drought conditions has resulted in an increased demand to use stock routes and roads for grazing in the North Burnett, with Council receiving an enquiry for several hundred of head to be travelled from further west onto local stock routes and roads.

The Queensland Government has a network of dedicated stock routes under the *Stock Route Management Act* which also includes roads by definition.

Any agistment or travelling of livestock on roads or stock routes requires a permit under the Act, and any road that involves a main road, would have to be referred to the relevant State agency for consideration.

Permit fees are based on the number of head to be travelled or agisted as determined by regulation under the Act. Local Governments can only refuse an application if there is a current permit with someone else, if there is no pasture or water to sustain stock during the period of the permit or if there is a risk to biosecurity, traffic or land. A refusal for permit can however be reviewed by the Government Department responsible for the Act.
