



Waste Management Fees

As of the 1st of July 2019, the following fees will apply at all Council's Waste Management Facilities. Contact the Environmental Health Section on 1300 696 272 or visit www.northburnett.qld.gov.au, if you require more information.

RECYCLABLES

Clean loads* of the following items are accepted as recyclables by North Burnett Regional Council:

Batteries	No charge
E-Waste	No charge
Waste Engine Oil (domestic quantities - < 150 litres)	No charge
Waste Engine Oil (domestic quantities - > 150 litres)	\$0.50c per litre
Waste Engine Oil – Commercial	\$0.50c per litre
Clean Fill	No charge
Drum Muster – approved containers only, triple rinsed	No charge
Cardboard and Paper Waste - Flattened	No charge
Cardboard – Unflattened	\$10.00 per m ³
Ferrous and Non-Ferrous Metals	No charge
Types 1, 2, & 5 Plastics (Refer to Plastic Recycling Fact Sheet on Council website) No charge when diverted to resource recovery otherwise general waste charges apply.	No charge

*Only items listed above are classed as recyclable. *Clean load means recyclable items have been separated and do not contain residue. It does not include any other waste which is chargeable.*

GENERAL WASTE (Domestic) – Excluding Tyres/ Asbestos and INCLUDING Green Waste

Domestic Waste Only – North Burnett residents/ratepayers (proof of current residency/ratepayer MUST be supplied at each visit to landfill)

Domestic Waste up to 1 m ³ (per day) (Includes Contaminated Green Waste)	No Charge
Domestic Waste above 1 m ³	\$11.00 per m ³ above 1 m ³
Green Waste (Uncontaminated) including tree waste and grass clippings – up to 1 m ³ (per day)	No Charge
Green Waste (Uncontaminated) including tree waste and grass clippings – above to 1 m ³	\$11.00 per m ³ above 1 m ³

GENERAL WASTE (Commercial) – Excluding Tyres/ Asbestos and INCLUDING Green Waste

COMMERCIAL WASTE ONLY – NORTH BURNETT BUSINESSES/RESIDENTS/RATEPAYERS (PROOF OF CURRENT RESIDENCY/RATEPAYER MUST BE SUPPLIED AT EACH VISIT TO LANDFILL)

Commercial General Waste (includes Contaminated green waste)	\$11.00 per m ³
Commercial Green Waste (Uncontaminated) including tree waste and grass clippings	\$11.00 per m ³
Large Loads (eg Tip Truck) per Tonne	\$20.00 per Tonne

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION (Domestic and Commercial, excluding tyres/ asbestos)

All material \$38.50 for each cubic metre (m ³)	\$38.50 per m ³
Large Loads (eg Tip Truck) per Tonne	\$200.00 per Tonne

CLEAN FILL

Uncontaminated material suitable for landfill cover and placed where requested	No charge

CHIPPED GREENWASTE

Mulch Sales – per m ³ (Self load) – there is no guarantee of quantities being available	No Charge

REGULATED WASTE

Asbestos (min charge \$35.00) – by appointment and subject to approval by Manager of Environmental Services prior to disposal	\$115.50 per m ³
Contaminated Soil – subject to written approval by Environmental Services (Acceptance subject to waste acceptance criteria as per individual Landfill Licence)	\$115.50 per m ³

Small (dog, cat etc.)	\$17.00 per animal
Medium (goat, sheep, calf etc.)	\$39.00 per animal
Large (horse, cow, bull etc.)	\$221.00 per animal
TYRES (per single tyre unit)	
Motorbike/ Car/ Utility	\$7.00 per tyre
4WD	\$9.00 per tyre
Truck to Super Single	\$25.00 per tyre
Tractor	\$80.00 per tyre
Tyres with rims – base cost plus	\$16.20 per tyre
Other Tyres At Cost – (Contact Manager Environmental Services)	POA - Minimum Fee \$90.00
MISCELLANEOUS	
Disposal of LPG Gas Bottles (empty only)	No Charge
Call out fee (for disposal outside normal hours based on min 3hrs) – Subject to availability	\$230.00
Invoice fee – administration fee for accounts per month	\$13.00
Bulky Items (Lounge chairs, Sofa-beds, Bookshelves)	\$10.00
MATTRESSES (Foam and Inner Spring)	\$9.00 each

Please note that customers are encouraged to provide the correct amount of money for disposal charges, as Waste Management Facilities do not keep large amounts of cash on site. Some facilities are unable to receive all 'Recyclable' or 'Regulated' wastes, please confirm with the facility or the Environmental Health Section as to what can be accepted.
