Maintenance	Council resourced funding utilised to undertake various works on Council roads, ranging from grading to pothole patching, installing guideposts and improving signage.
Gravel Resheet	Spreading and compacting a layer of gravel on an unsealed section of road to improve driveability and quality of the road.
TIDs	Transport Infrastructure Development Scheme (TIDs) is State Government funding designed for the development or upgrade of roads and transport related infrastructure.
Main Roads	Undertaking contractual works on behalf of the Department of Transport and Main Roads on the State Road Network.
Flood Resilience	The improvement of a flood prone asset to minimise damage and delays in access following a flood event.
Flood REPA	The Restoration of Essential Public Assets (REPA) following a flood event, replacing like for like.
Emergent Works	Immediate, temporary repairs following a disaster to provide, at a minimum, single lane commercial access.
Concrete Floodway	The improvement or replacement of a concrete floodway.
Pavement Rehab Pavement Reseal	Rehabilitation of a sealed pavement to remove defects and improve the life of the asset plus its safety and driveability.
Private Works	Contractual works undertaken for a private entity.
Capital	A project that helps maintain or improves Council's asset
